

A little later Mary and Joseph took Jesus to the temple to give Him to the Lord.


They also took two doves for a sacrifice.




At the temple lived an old prophet. His name was Simeon.

The Holy Spirit guided Simeon into the temple, at the same time Mary and Joseph were bringing Jesus to the temple.




When Simeon saw the baby he took Him in his arms.
