(Transfiguration)

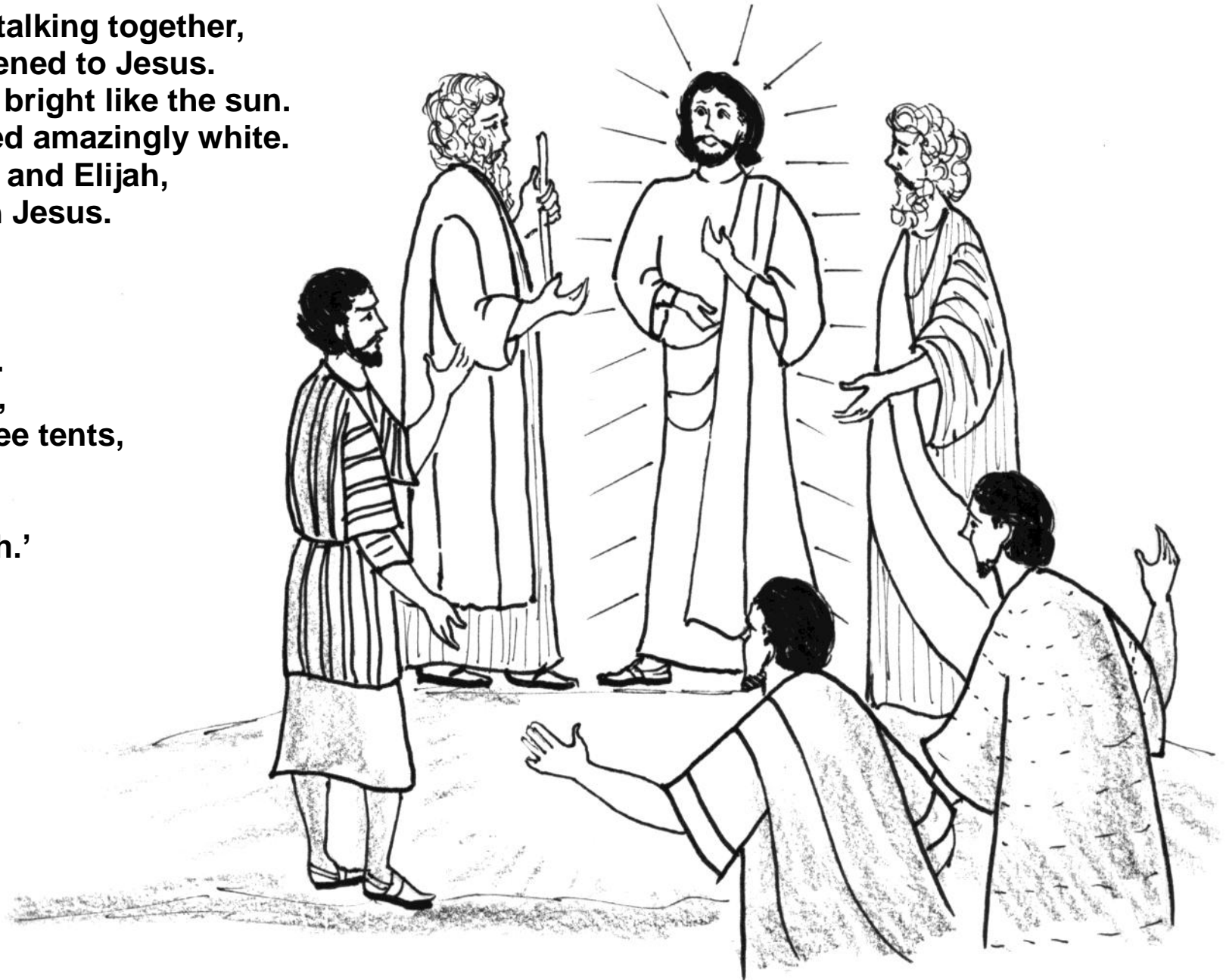

where they could be alone.**



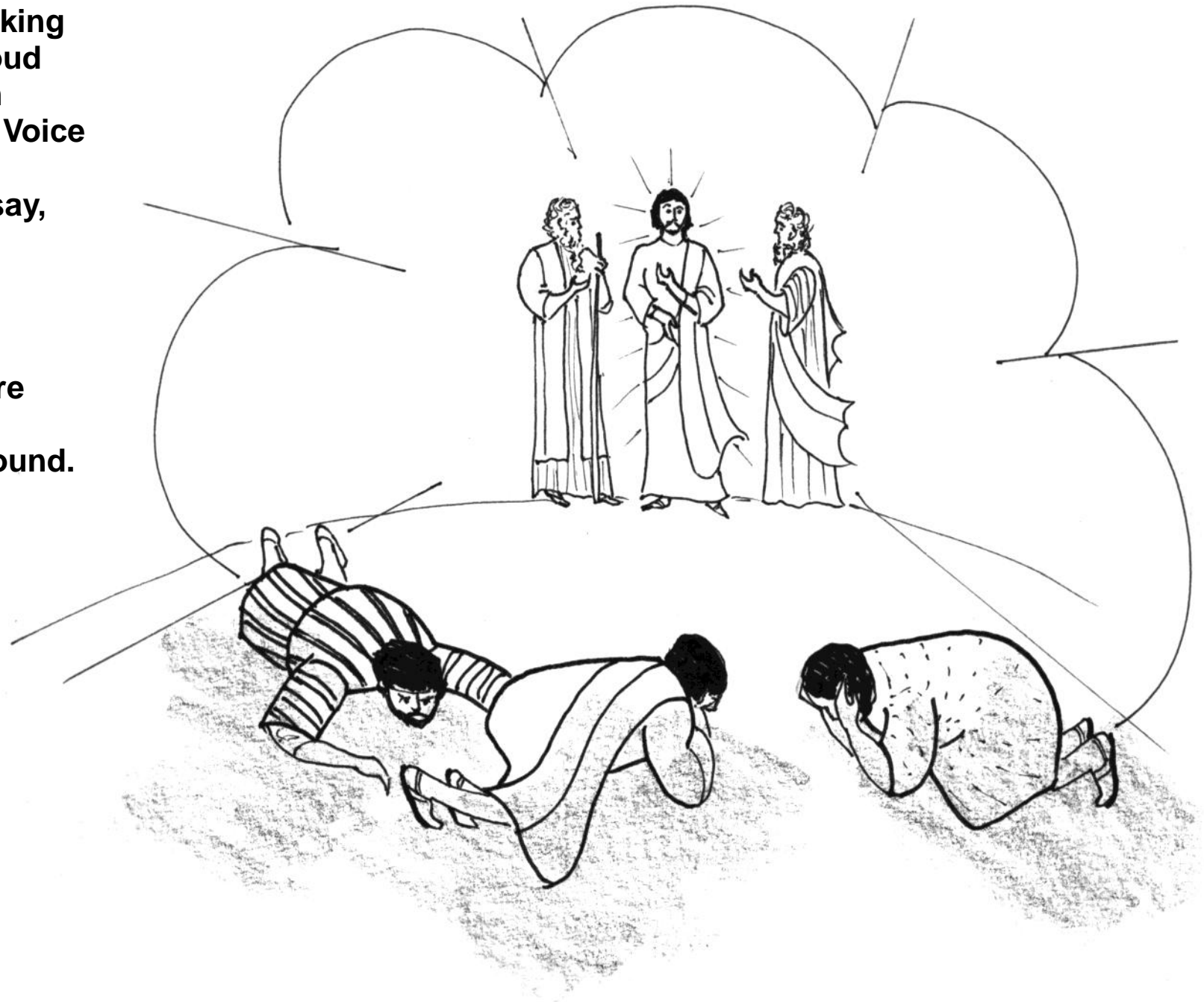
**While they were talking together,

and one for Elijah.'**

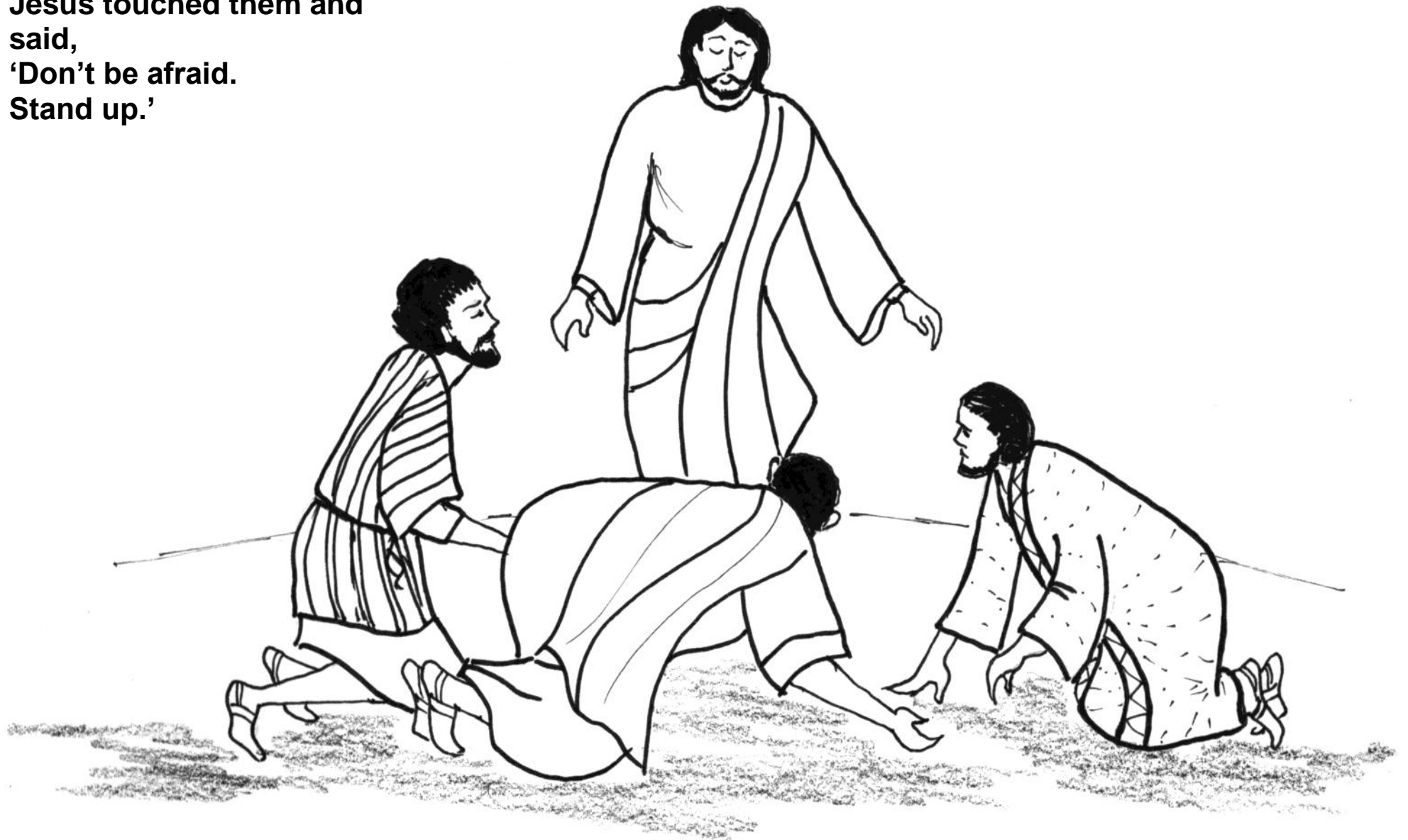


**Peter was still talking

Listen to Him.'**

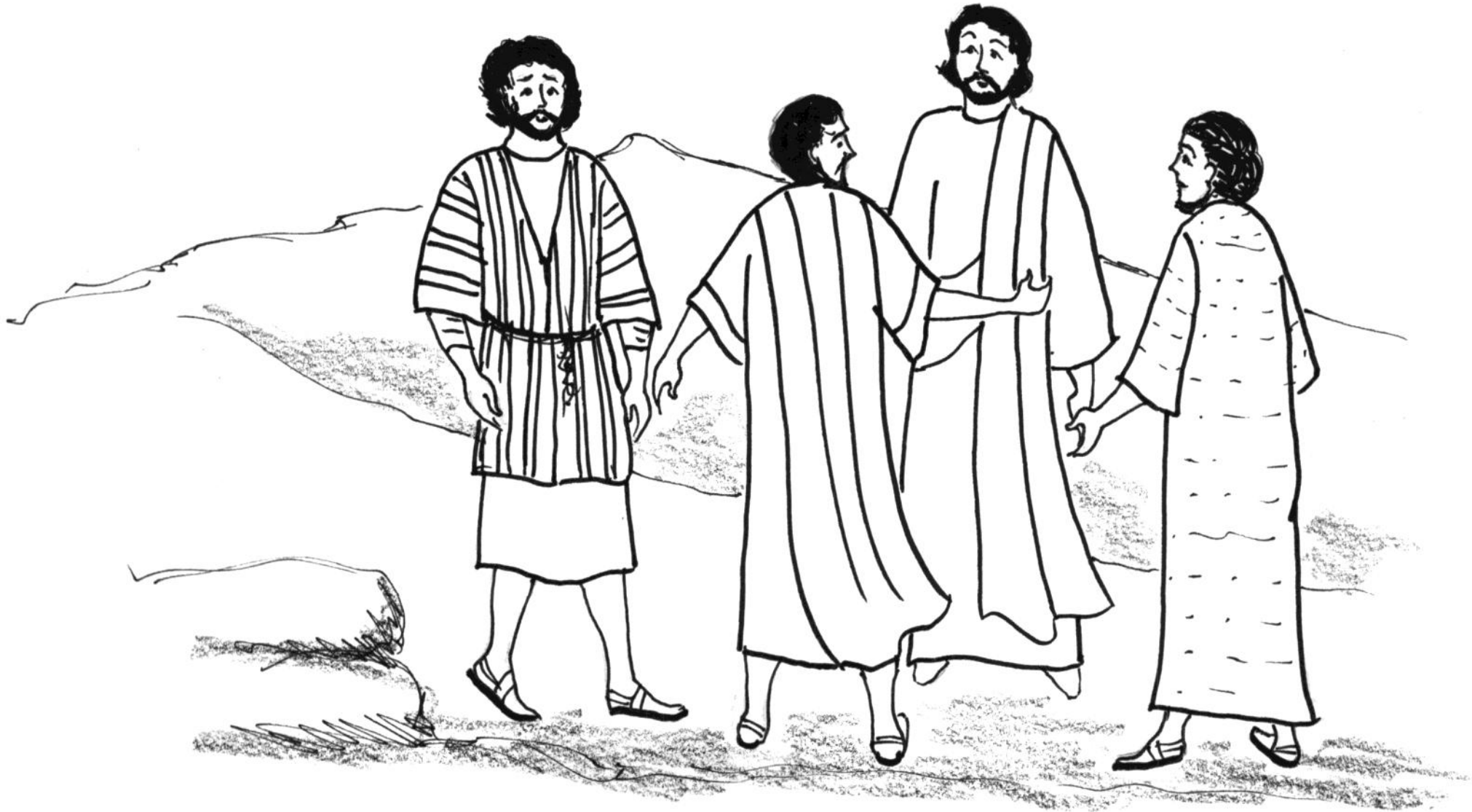
**The disciples were
