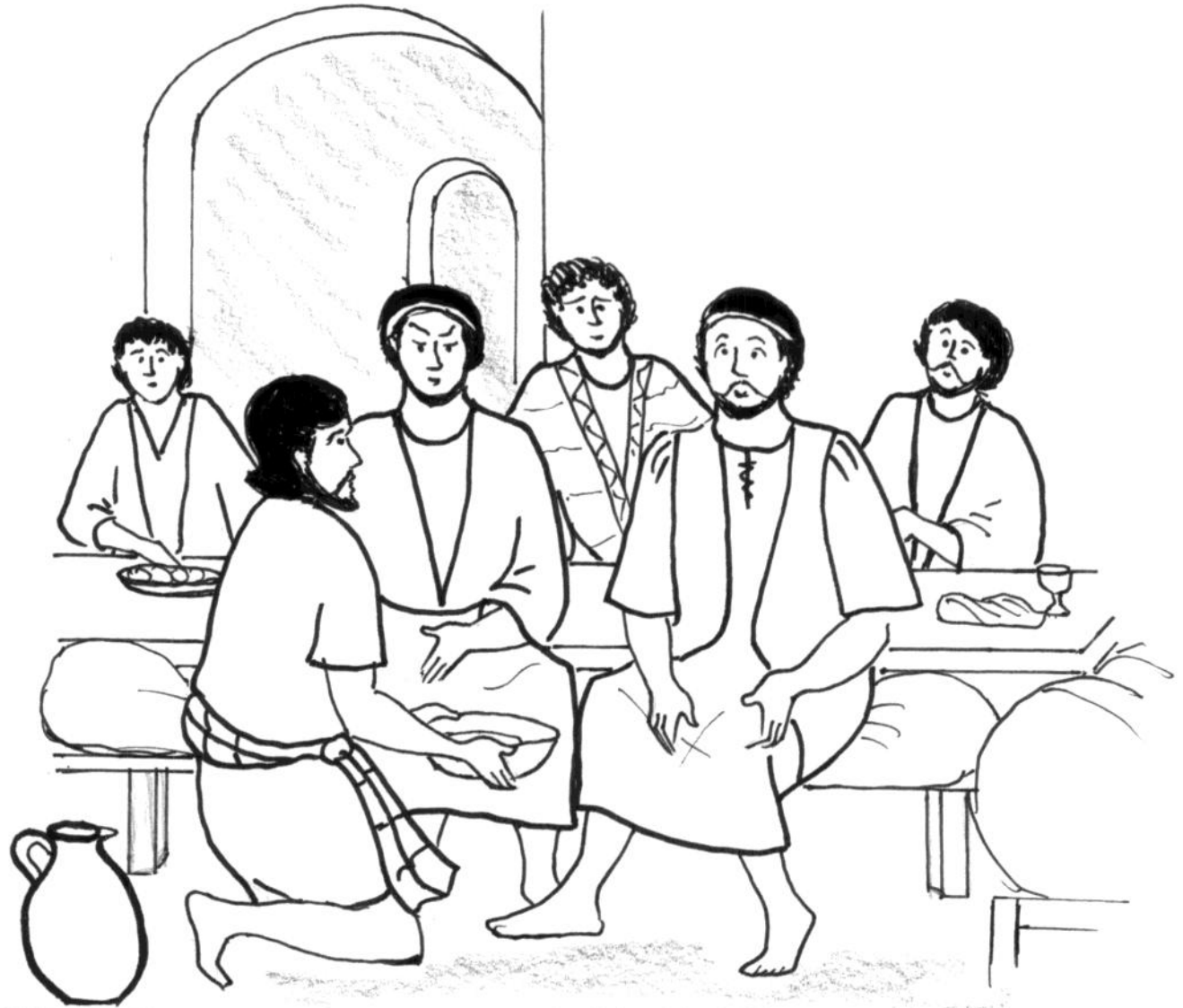

When everyone was seated a surprising thing happened. Jesus took off His coat, put a towel around Himself and began washing the disciples' feet.

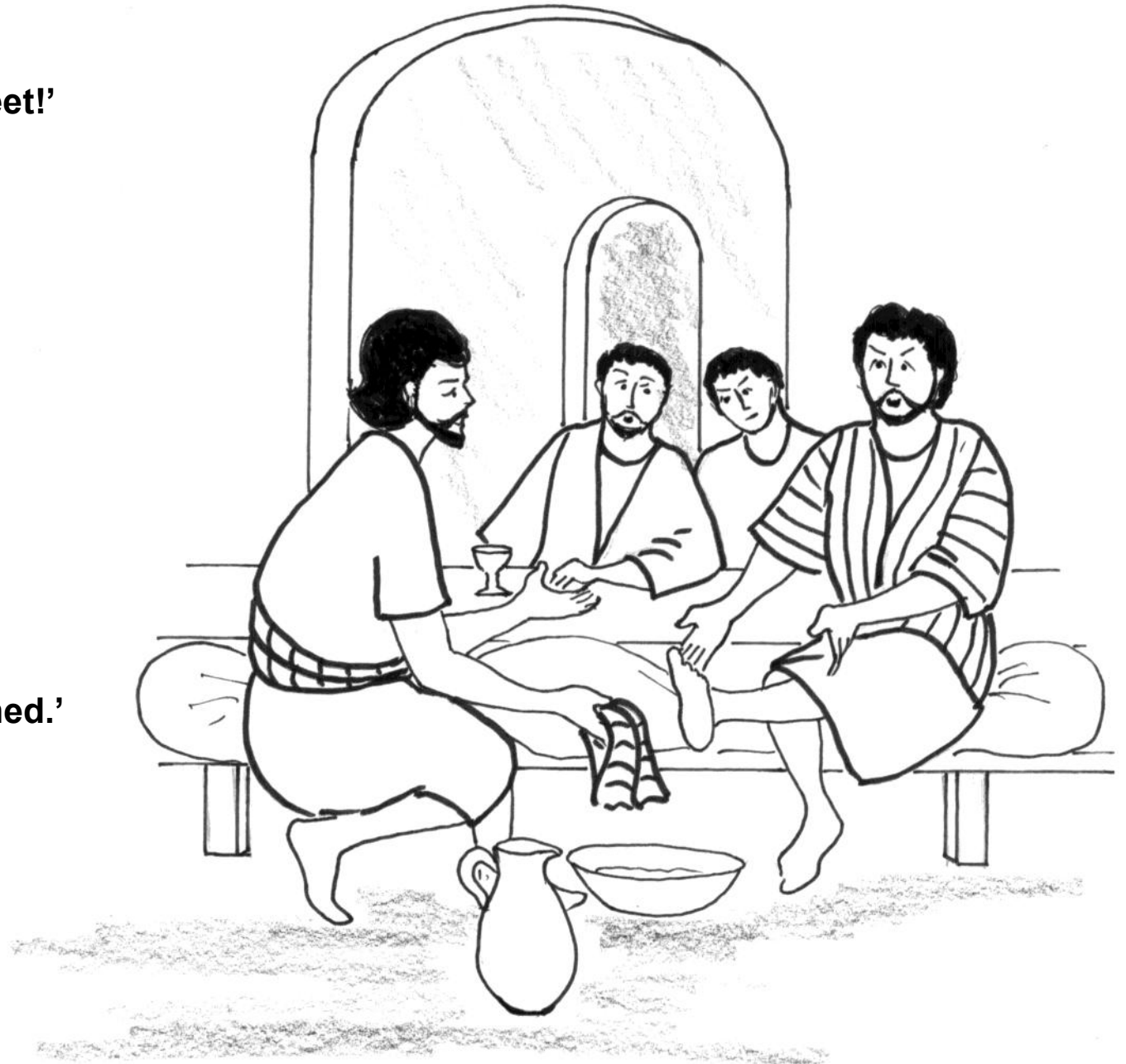


**When He came to Peter,

anything from Me.'**

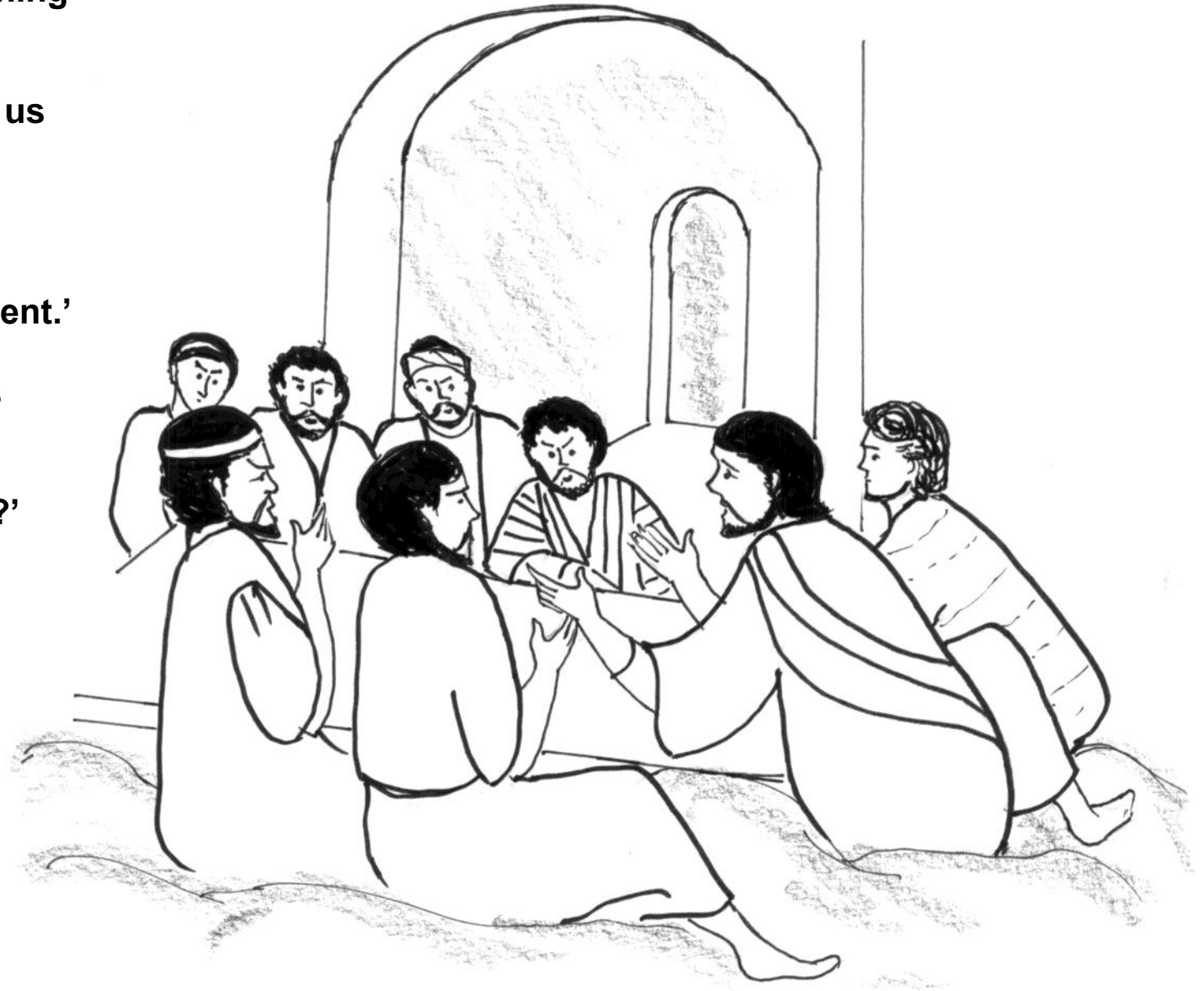
**Then Peter cried,

'You only need your feet washed.'**



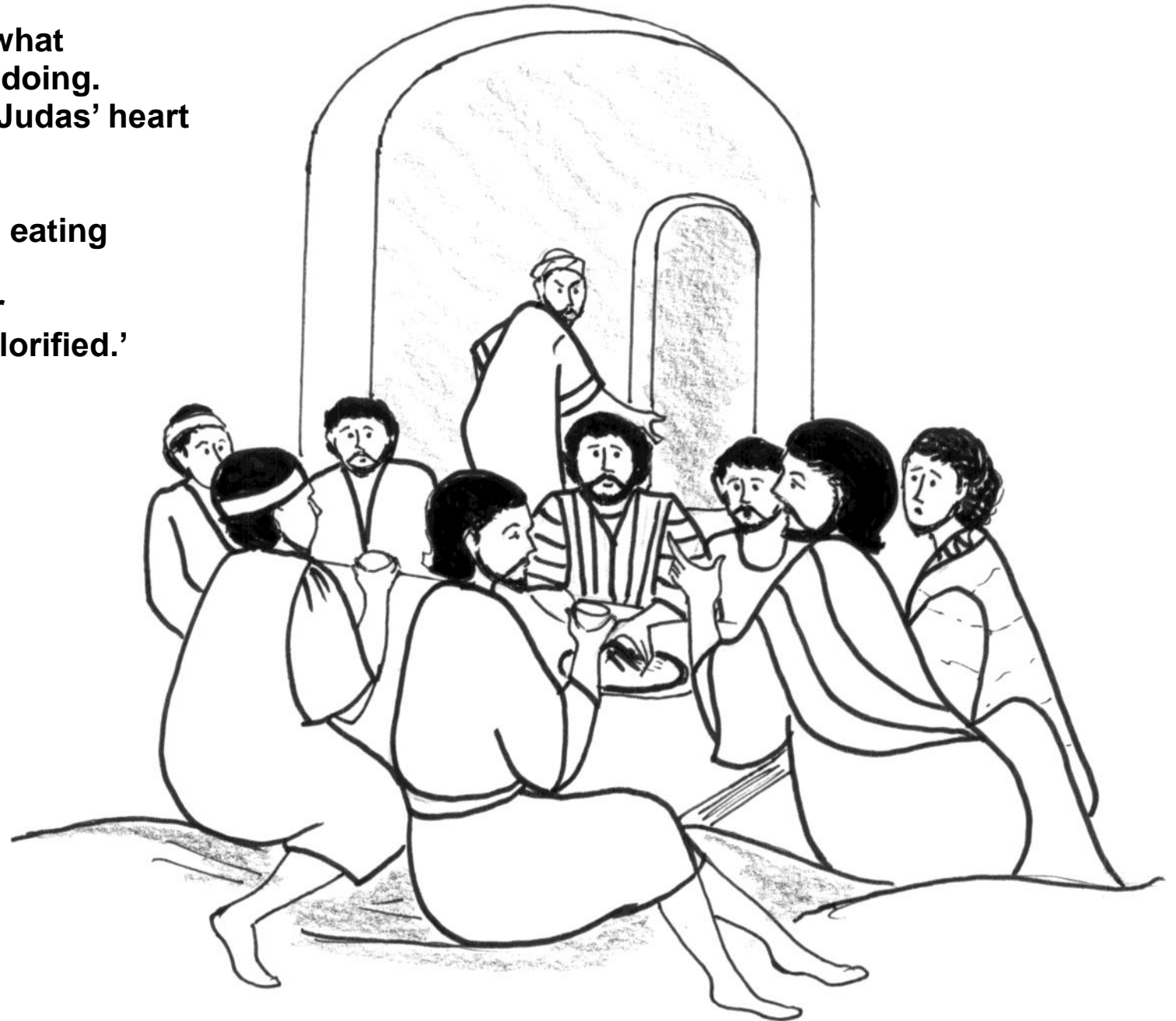
**When Jesus finished washing

who will turn against You?'**



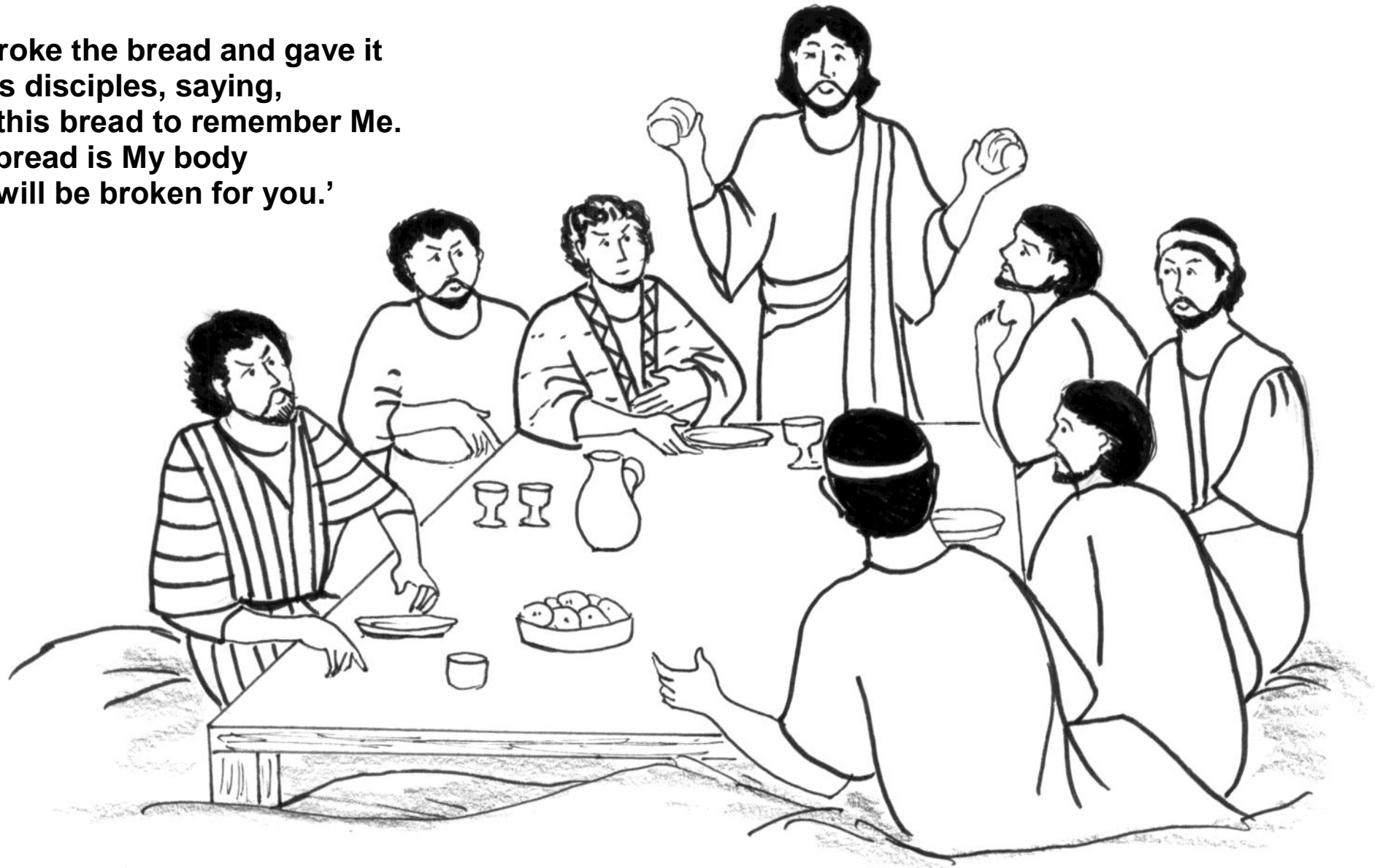
**It was Judas.
