for the Passover.**

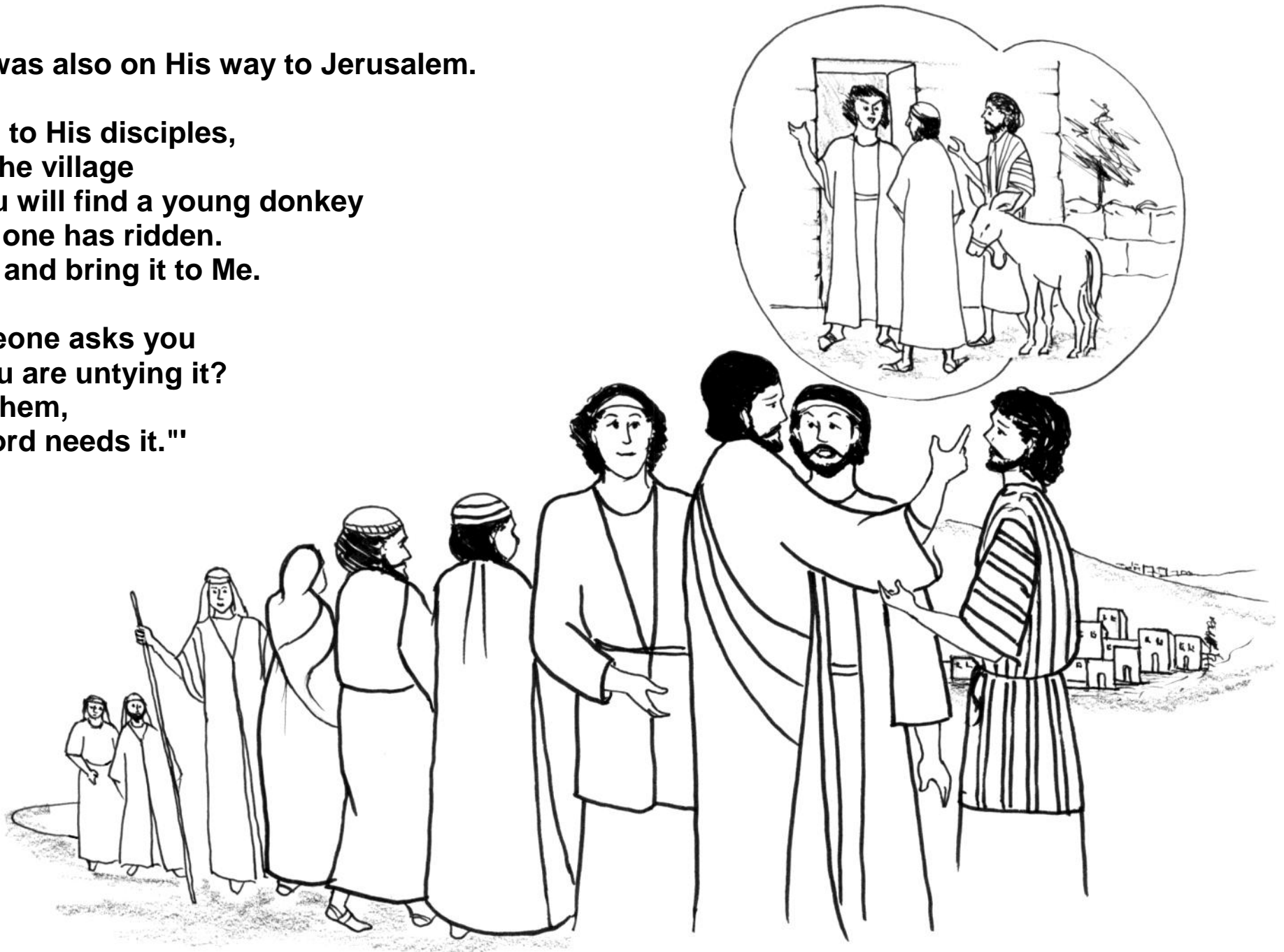
**As they walked they sang,

Jesus was also on His way to Jerusalem.

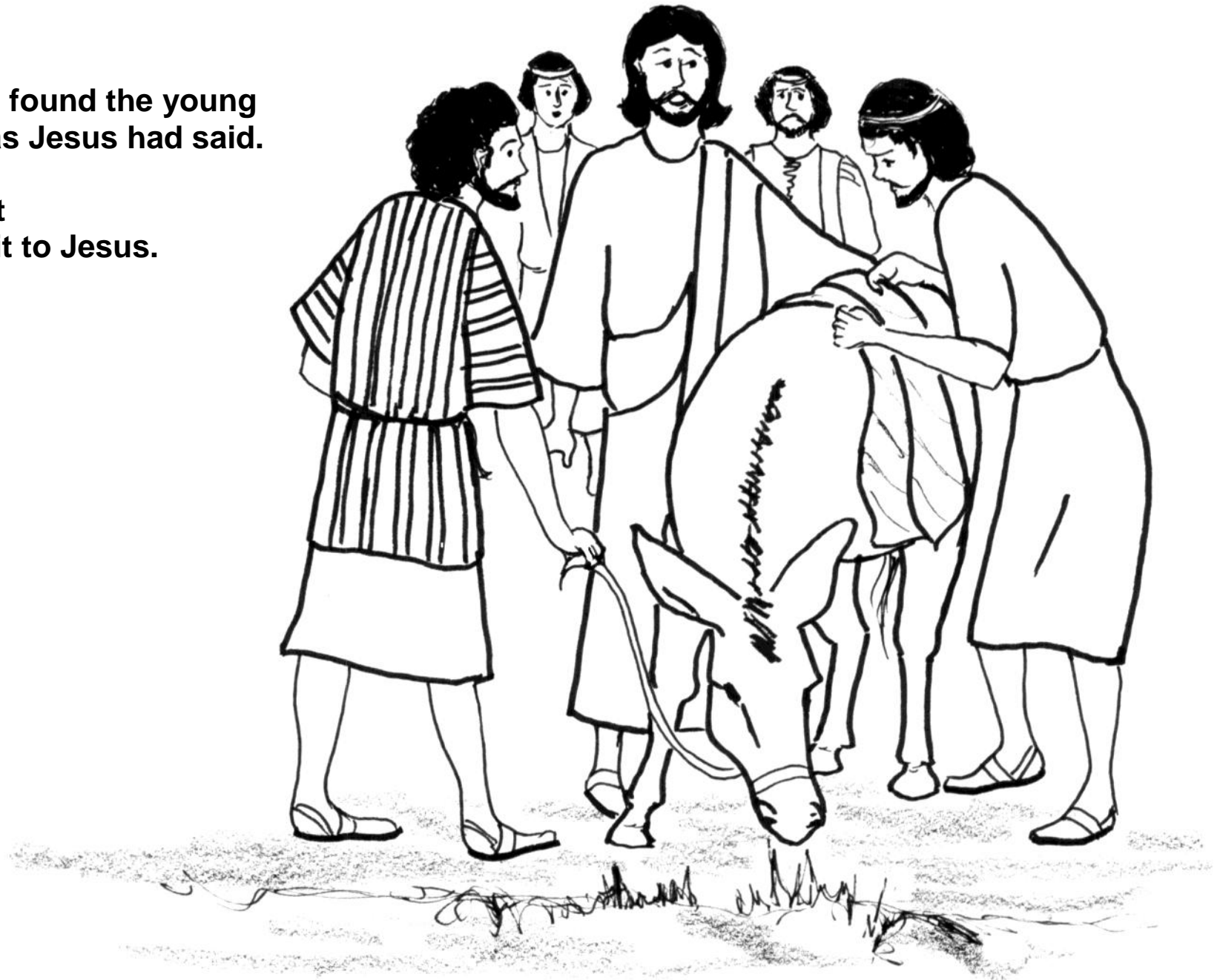
**He said to His disciples,

"The Lord needs it."'**



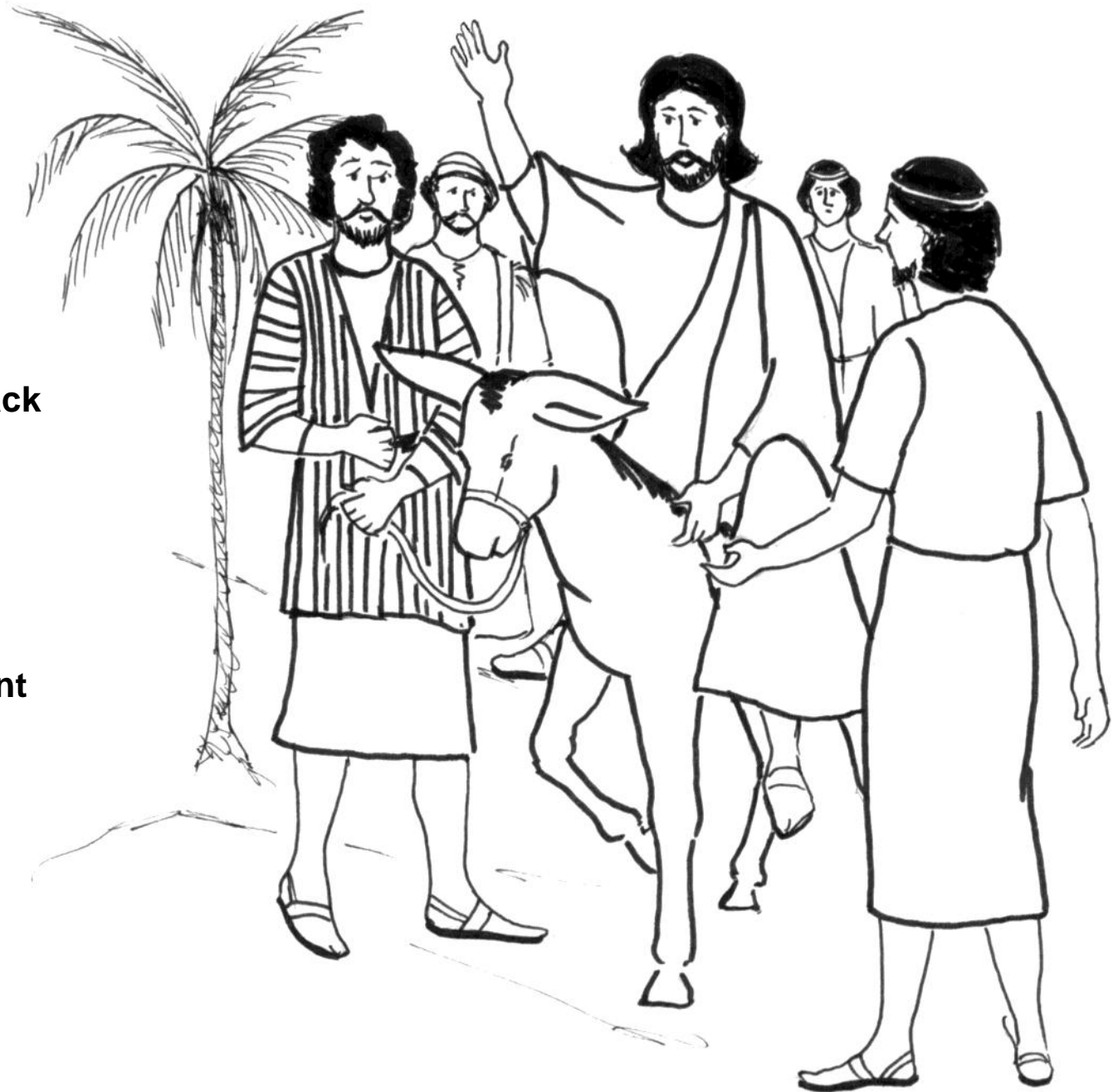
The disciples found the young donkey just as Jesus had said.

They untied it and brought it to Jesus.



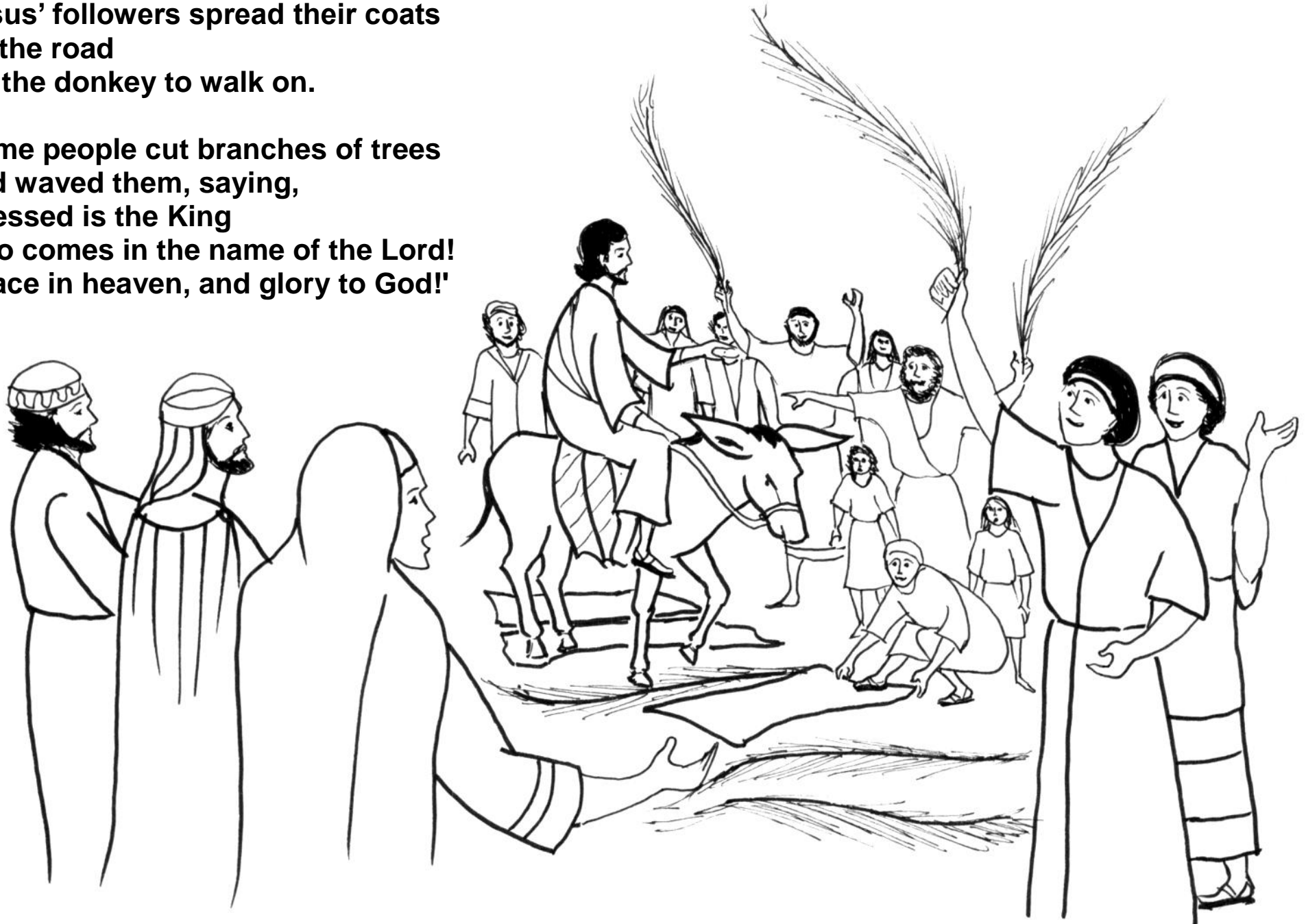
**They threw a coat on its back

everyone following Jesus.**

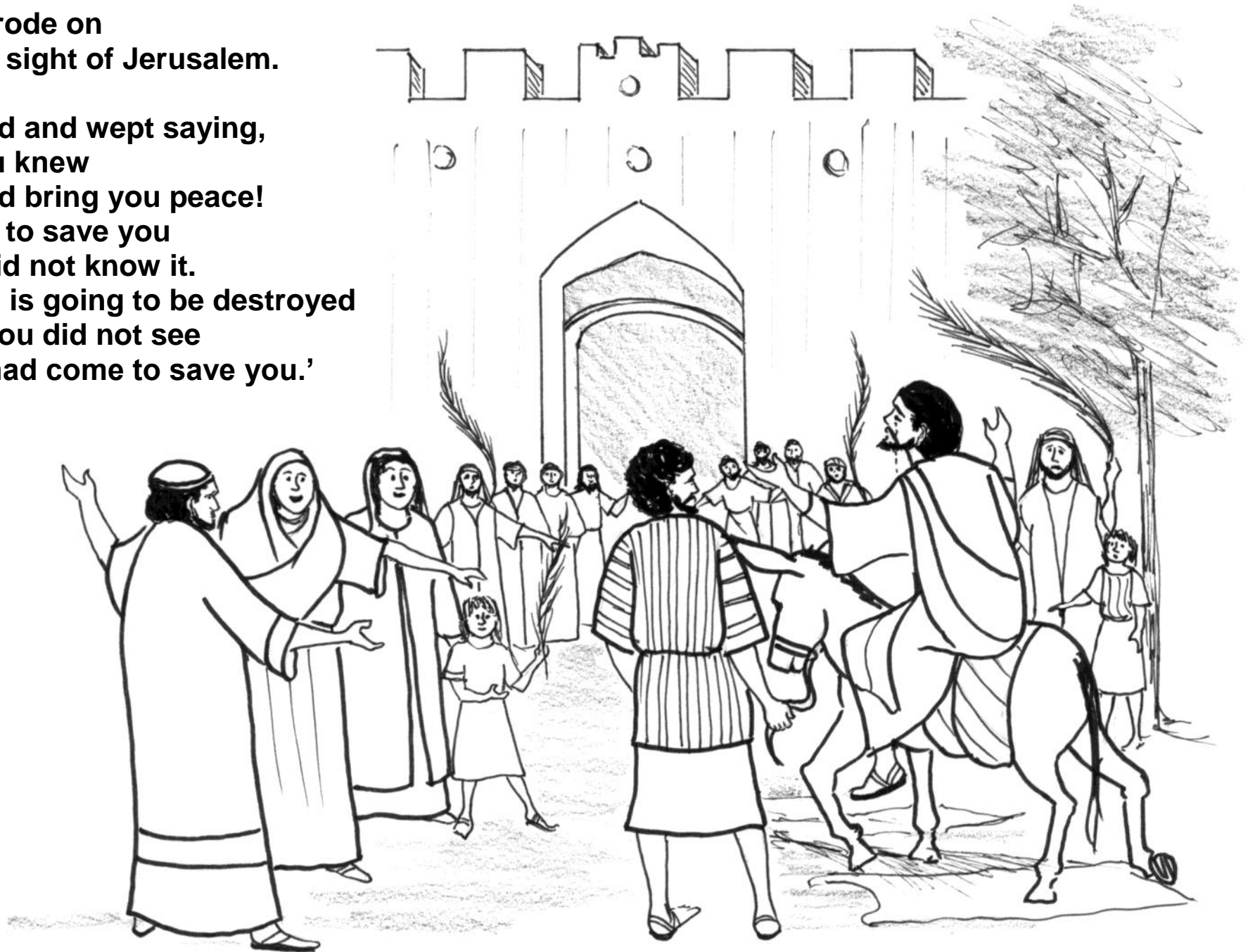
**They said to Jesus,

the stones will do it instead!'**

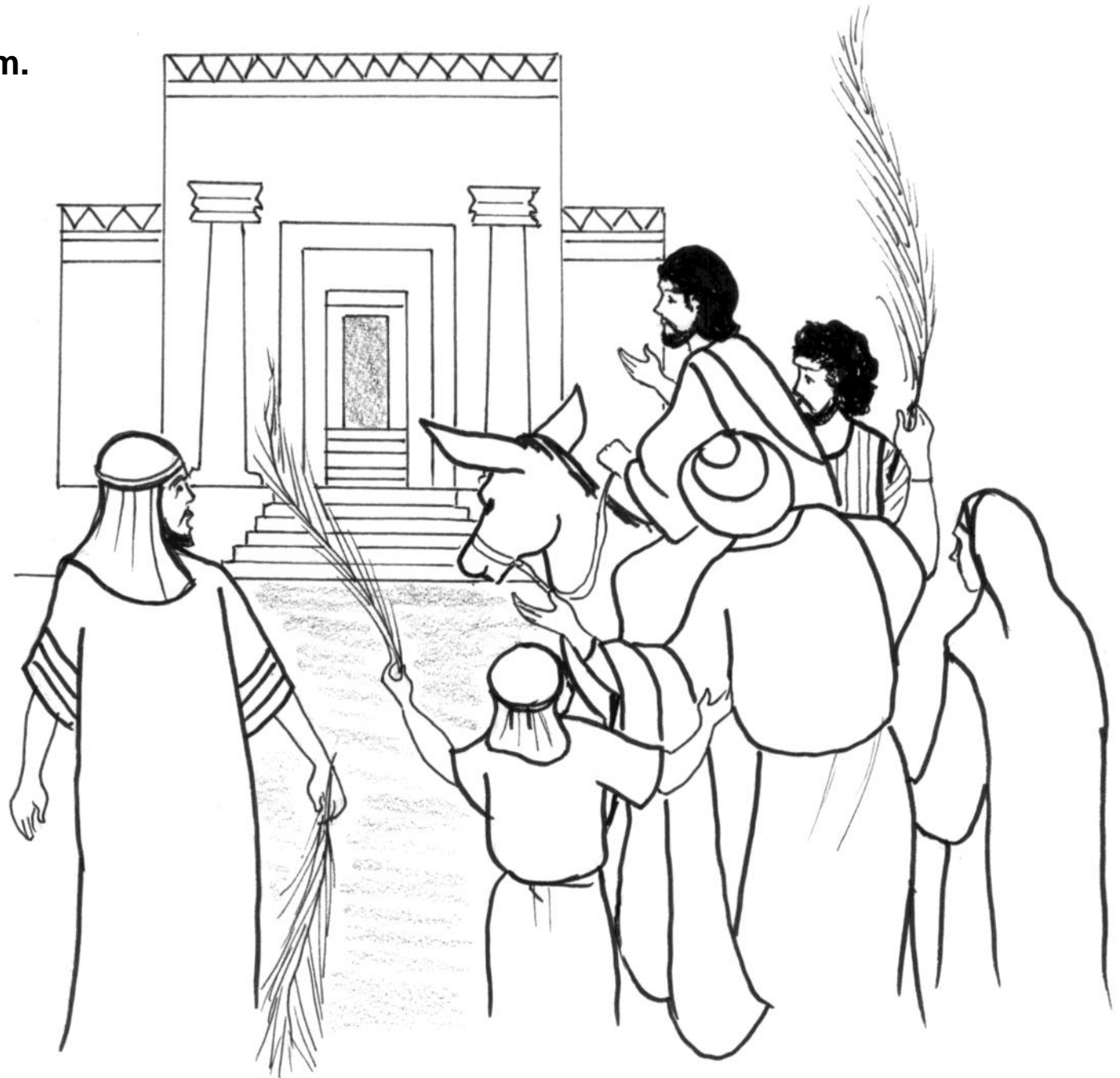


**As Jesus rode on

that God had come to save you.'**

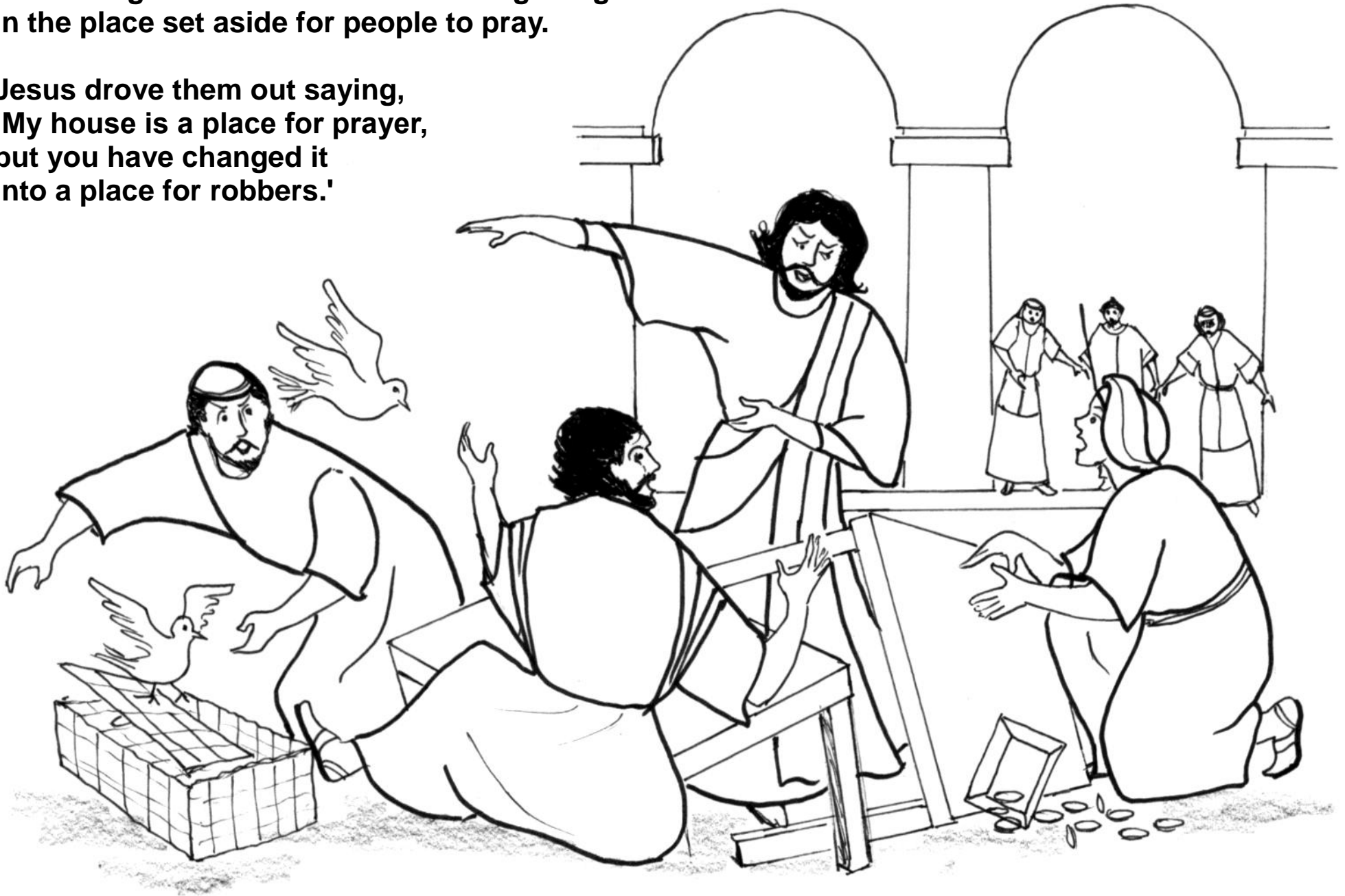


**Jesus went on riding
