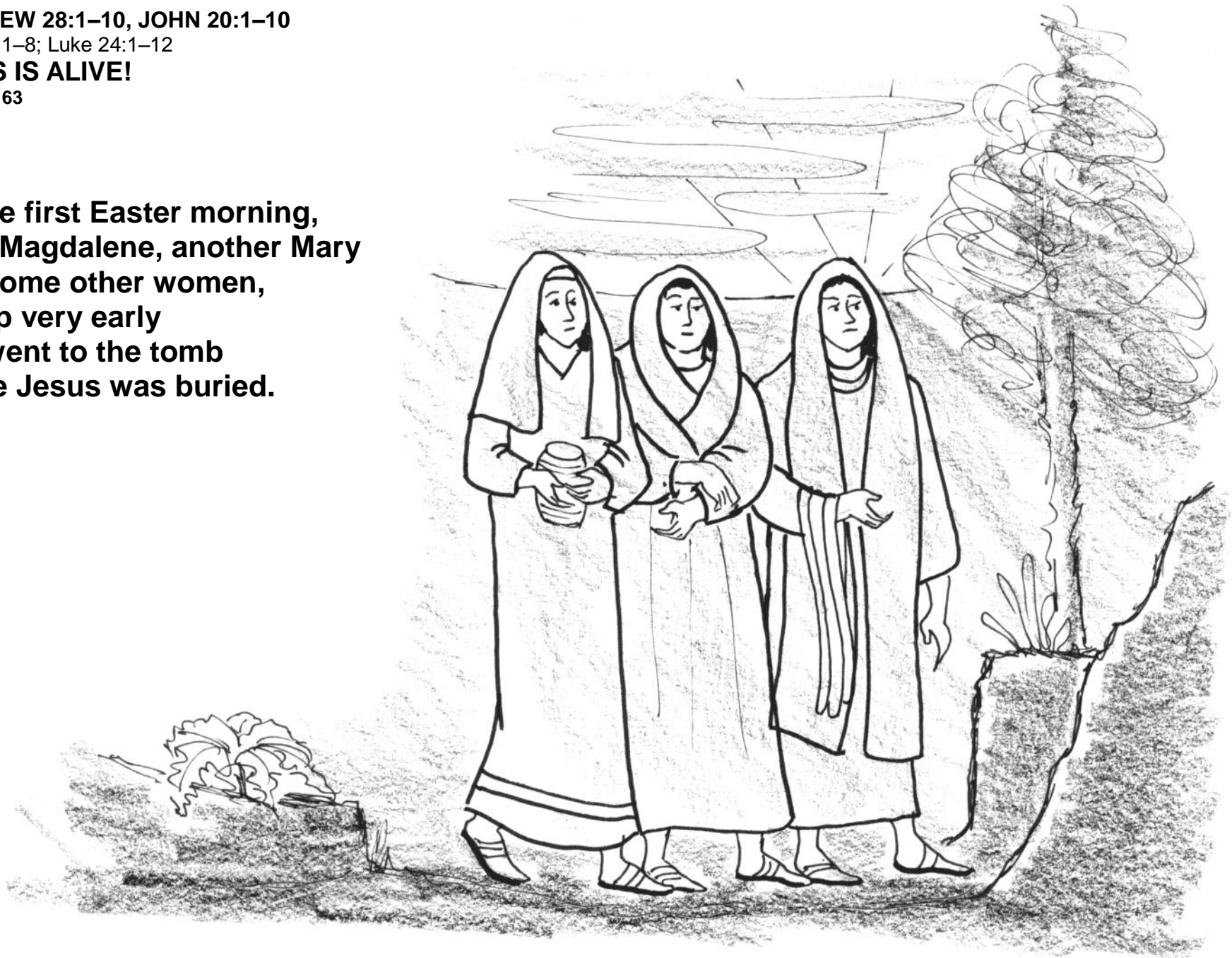

JESUS IS ALIVE!

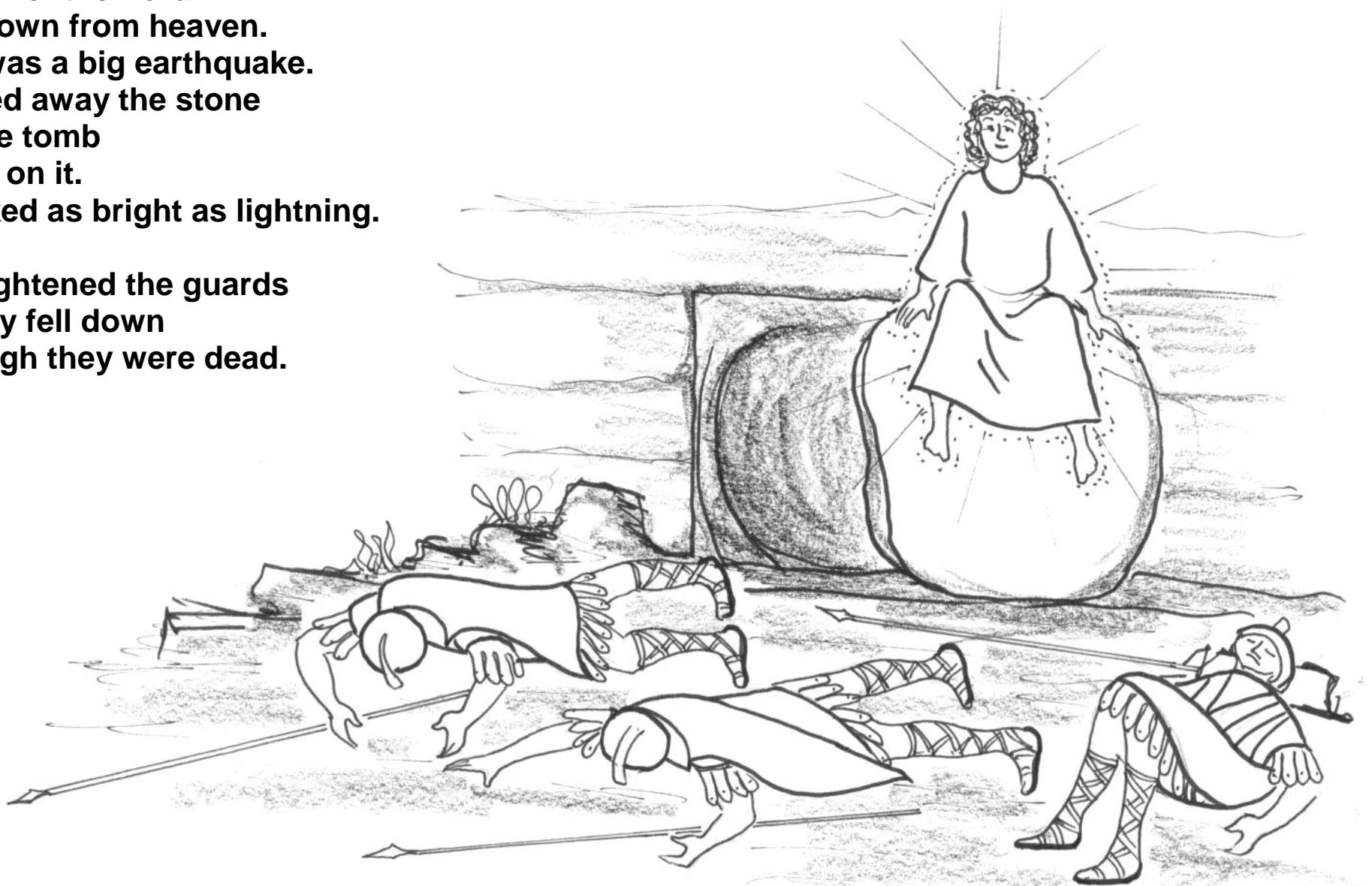

where Jesus was buried.**



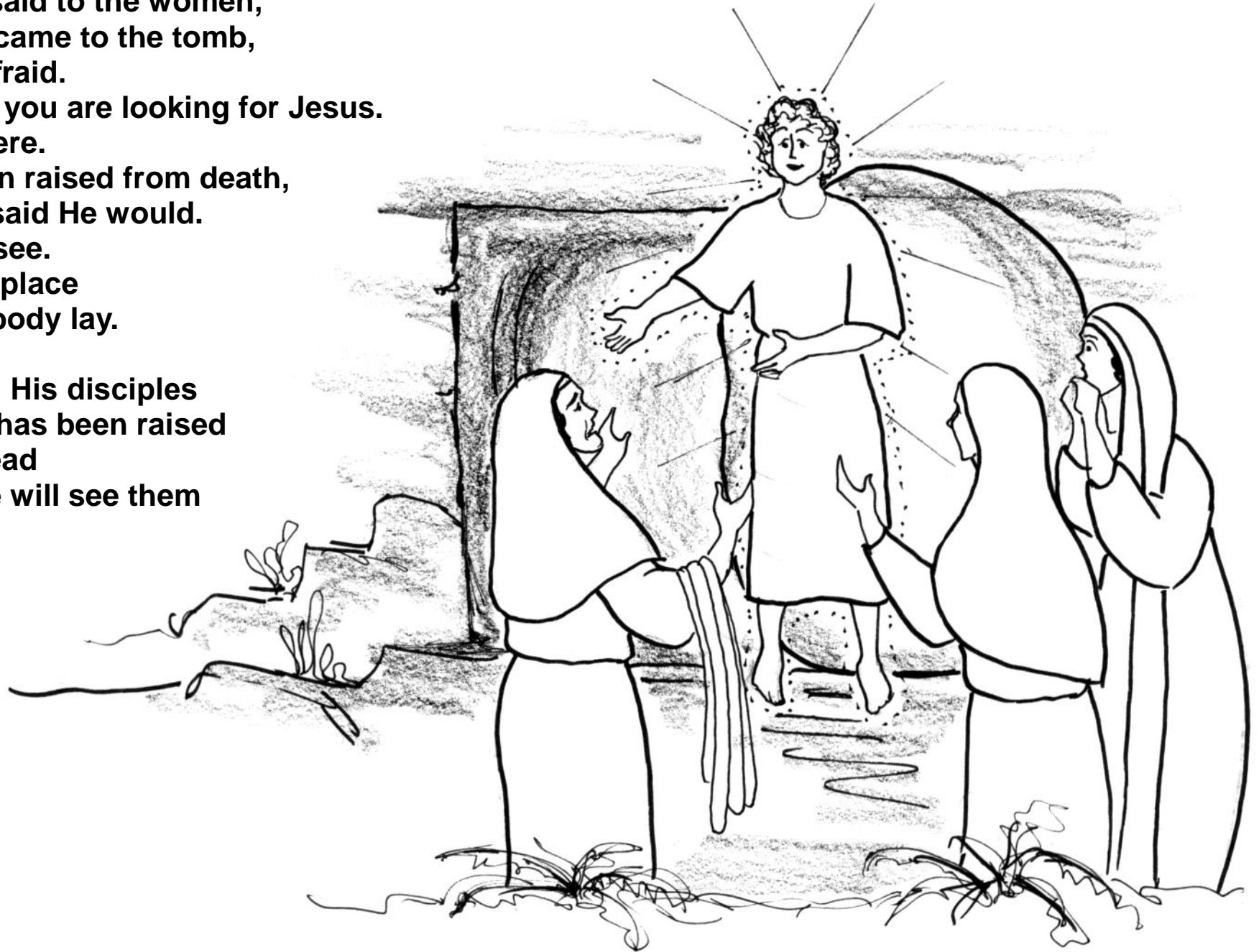
**At the same time

in Galilee.'**



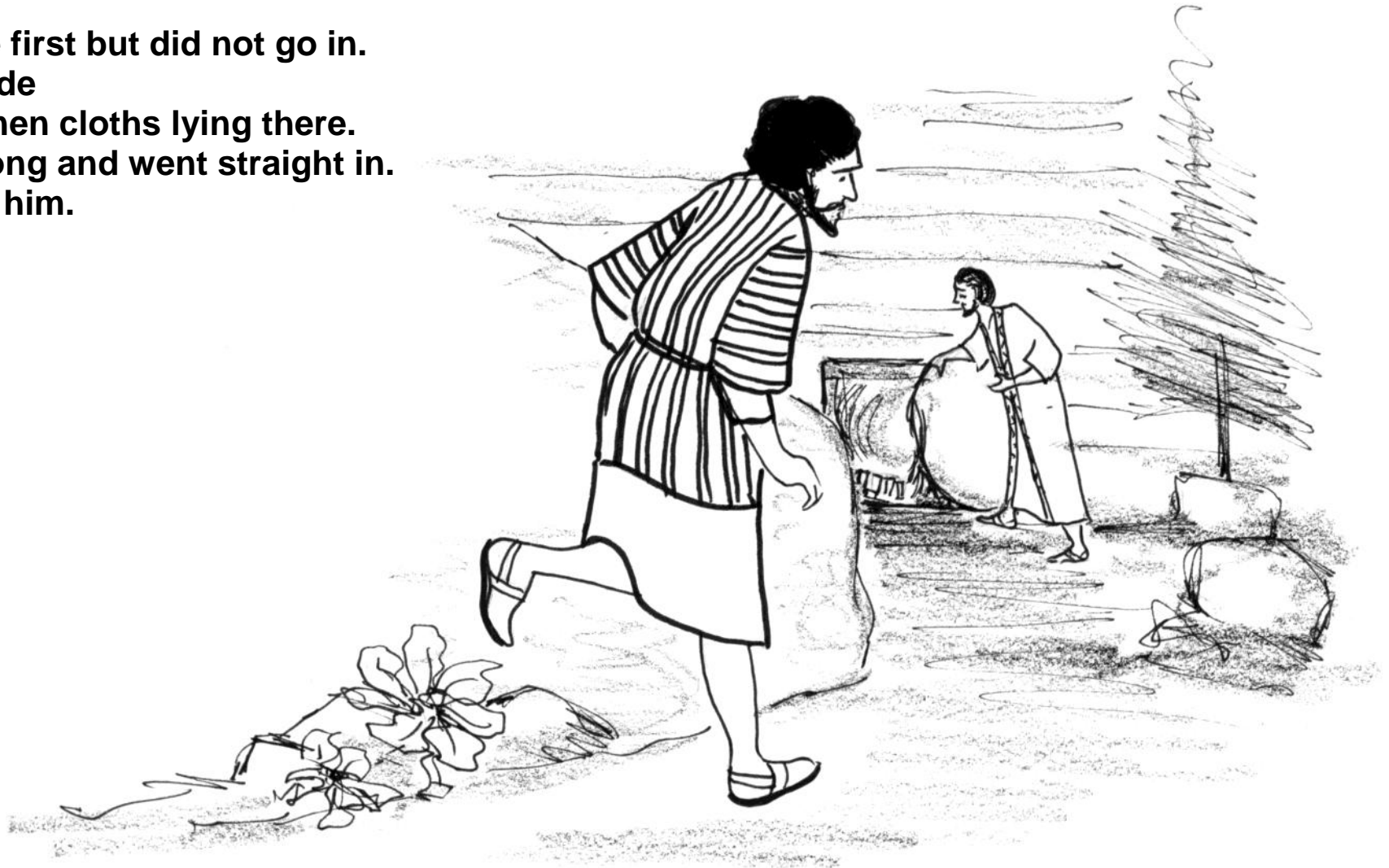
**The women were afraid but happy.
