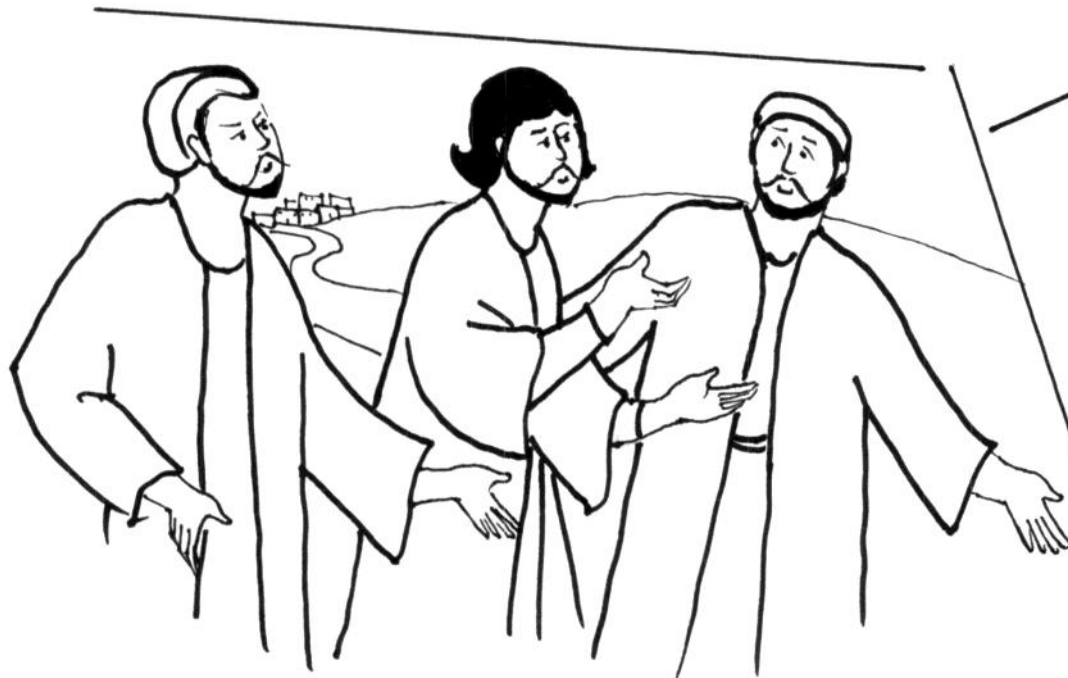

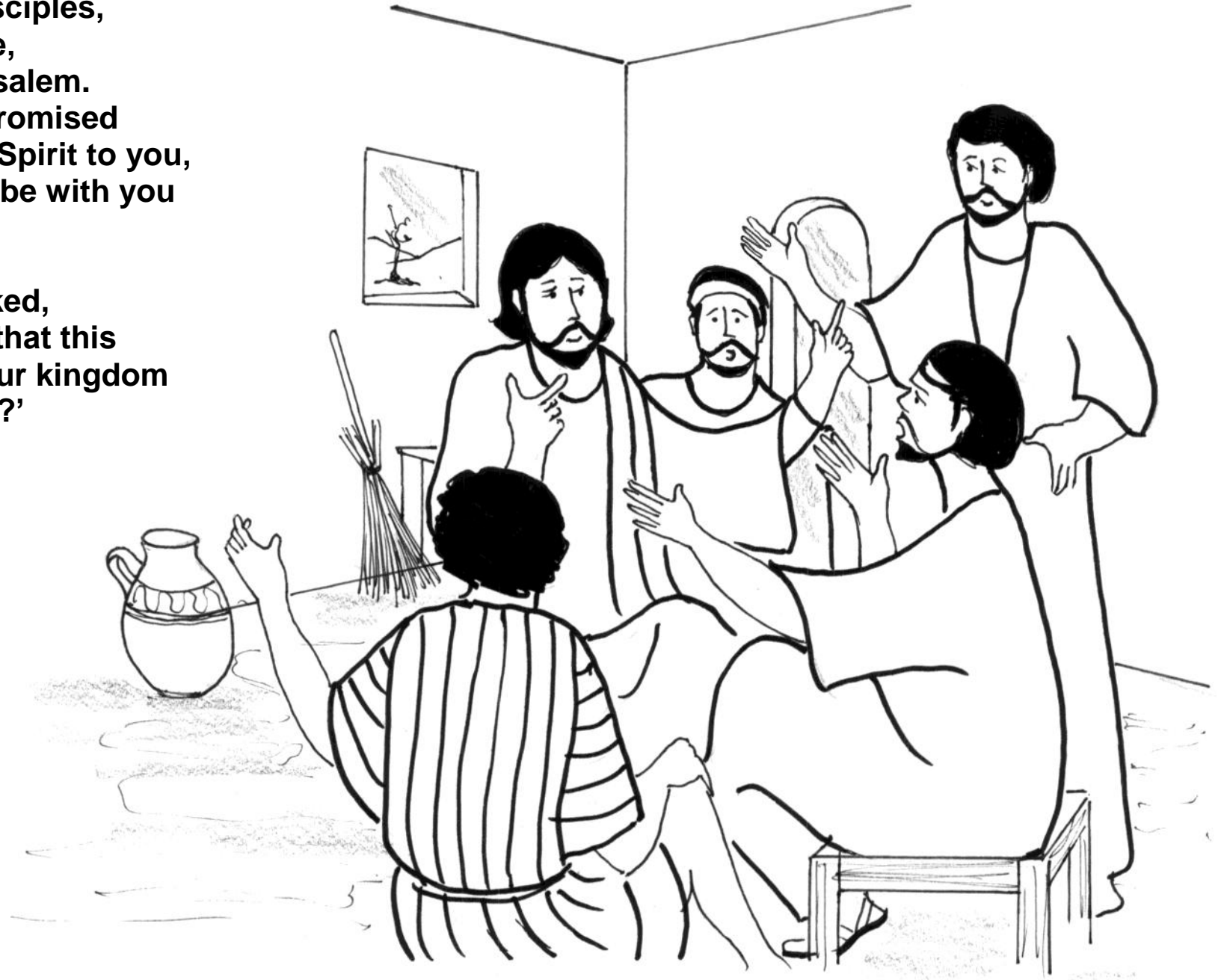

so they could see that He was alive.**



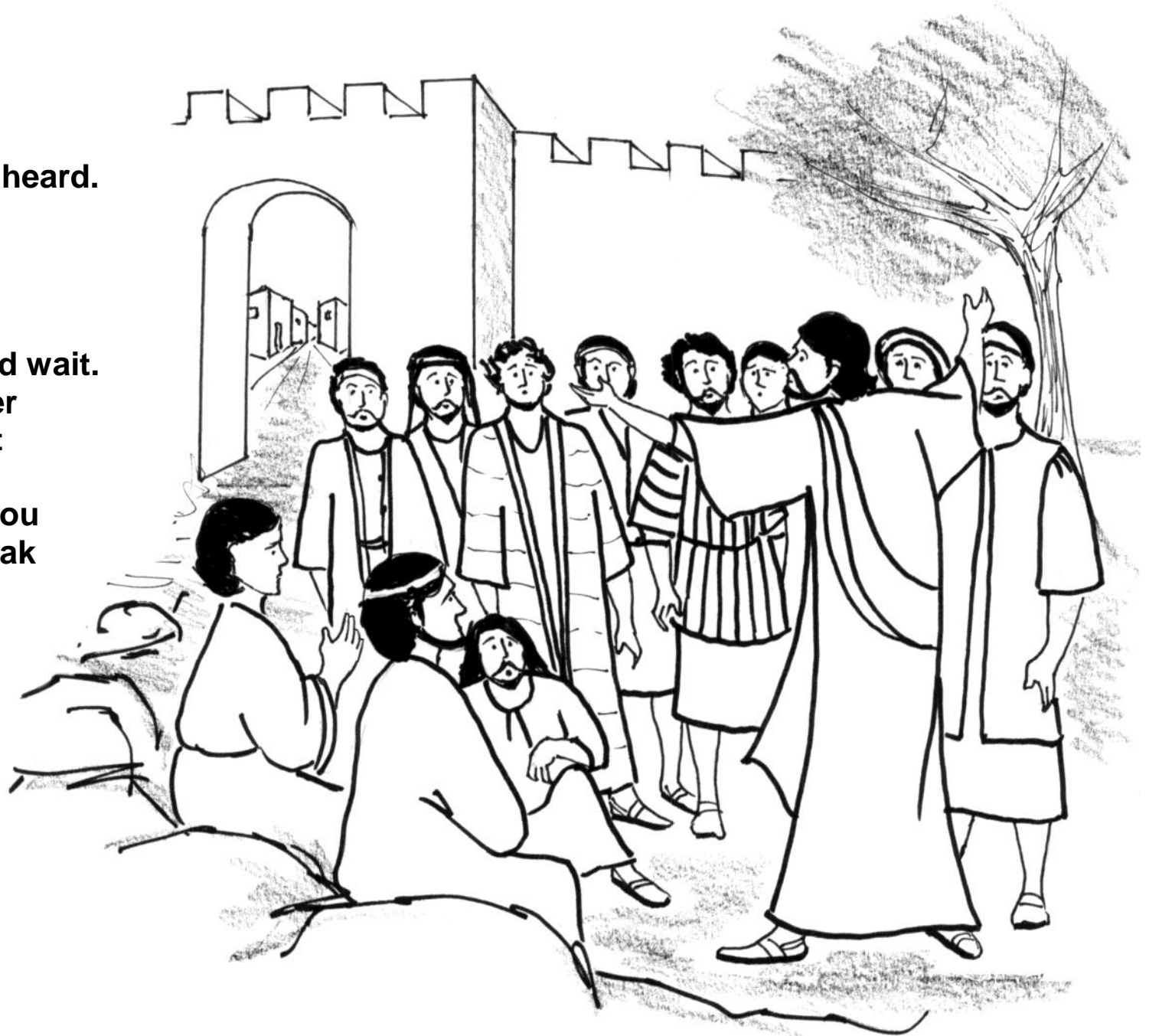
**He said to His disciples,

to come on earth?'**



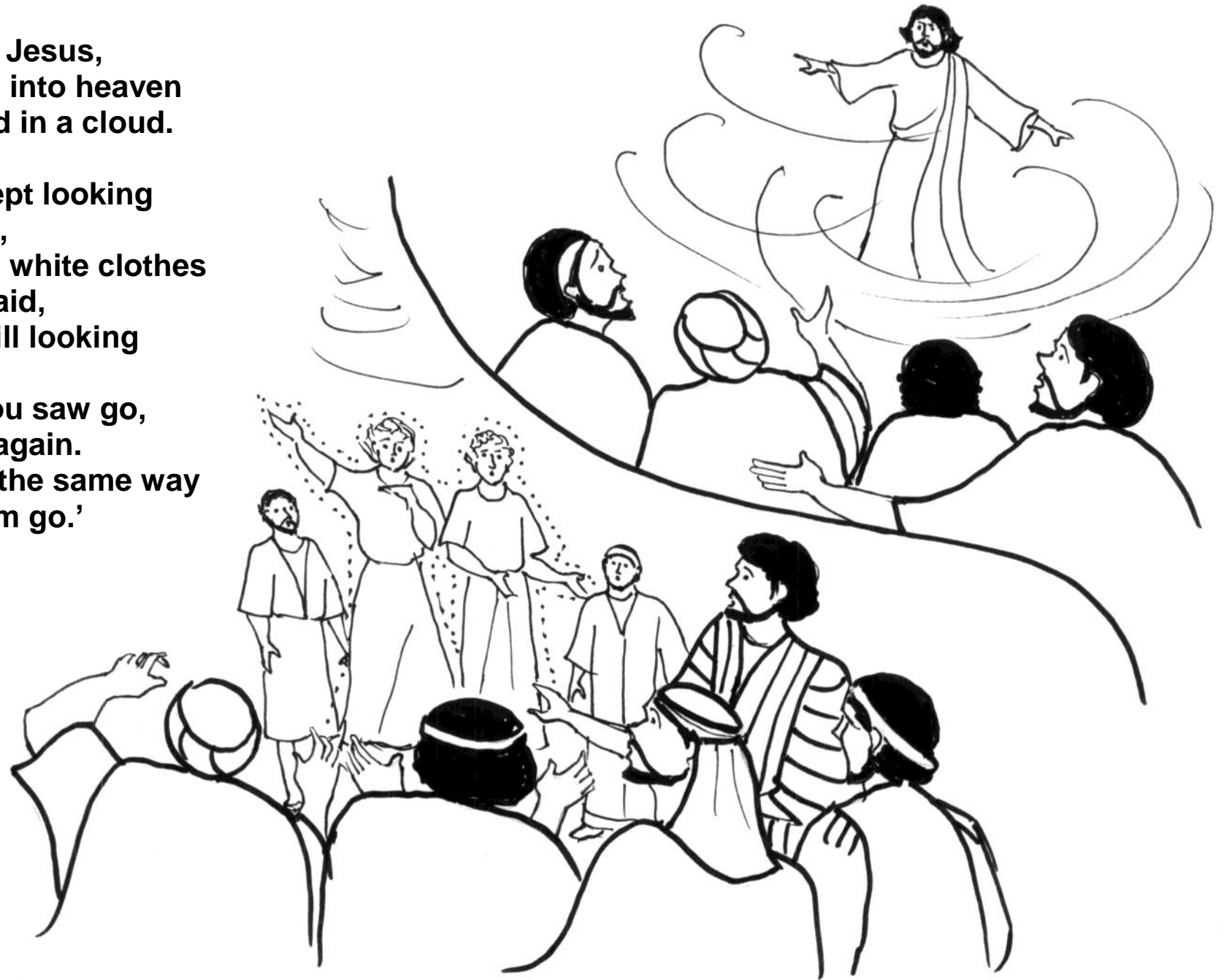
**Jesus said,

My word.'**

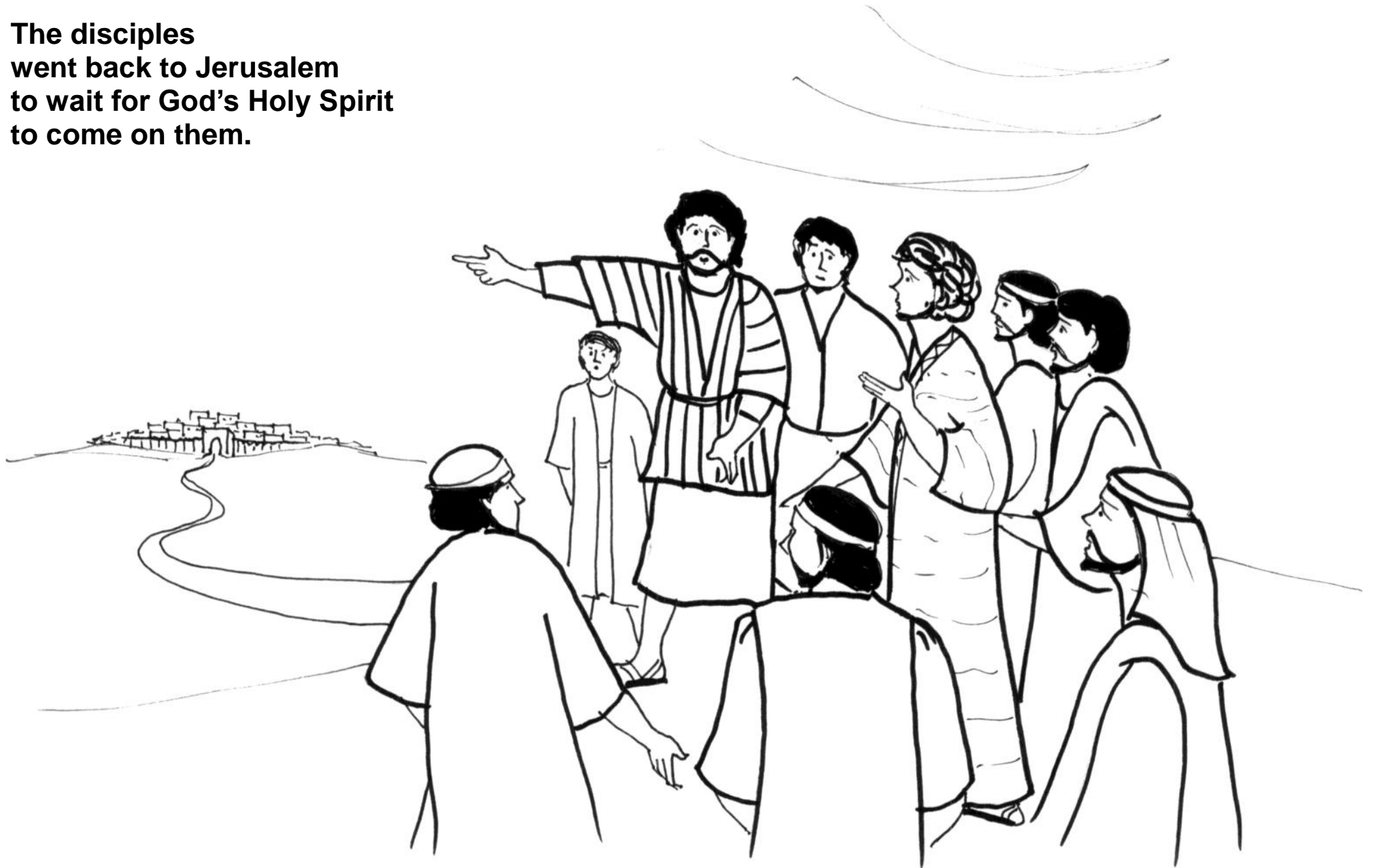


**While everyone
