carried his shield.

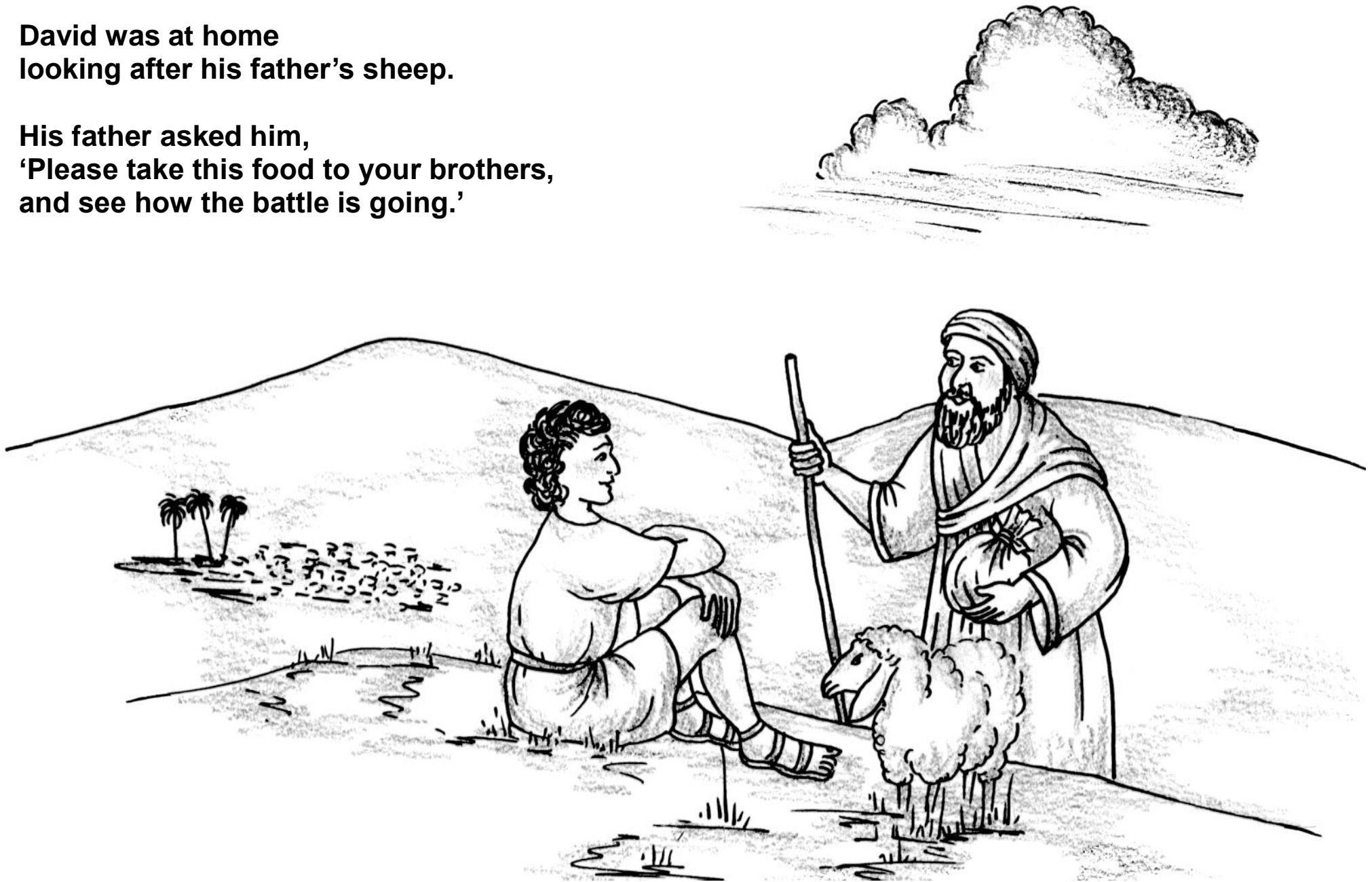
Goliath shouted to the Israelites.

I'll go out and fight the Philistine.'**

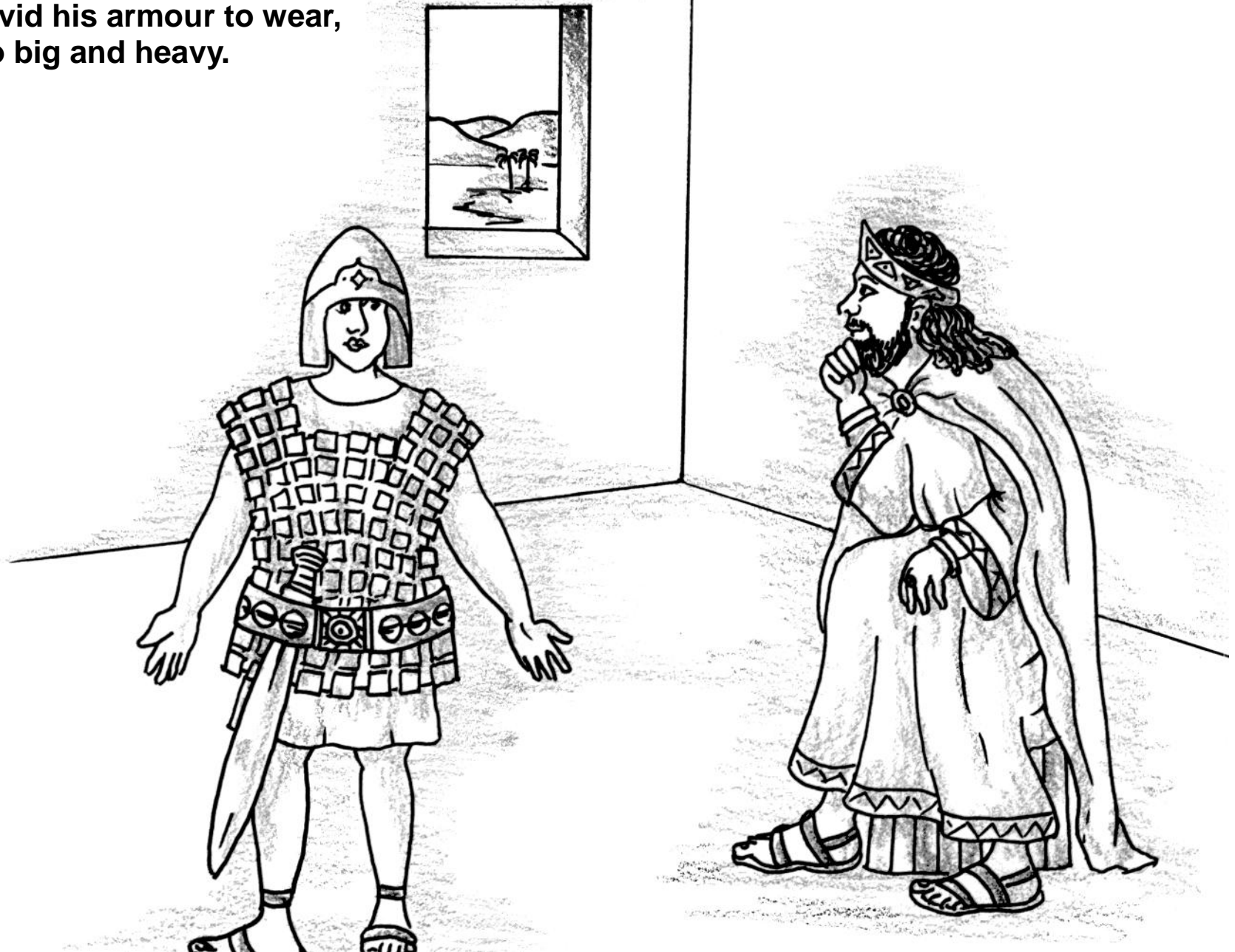
**Saul looked at David and said,

said King Saul.**

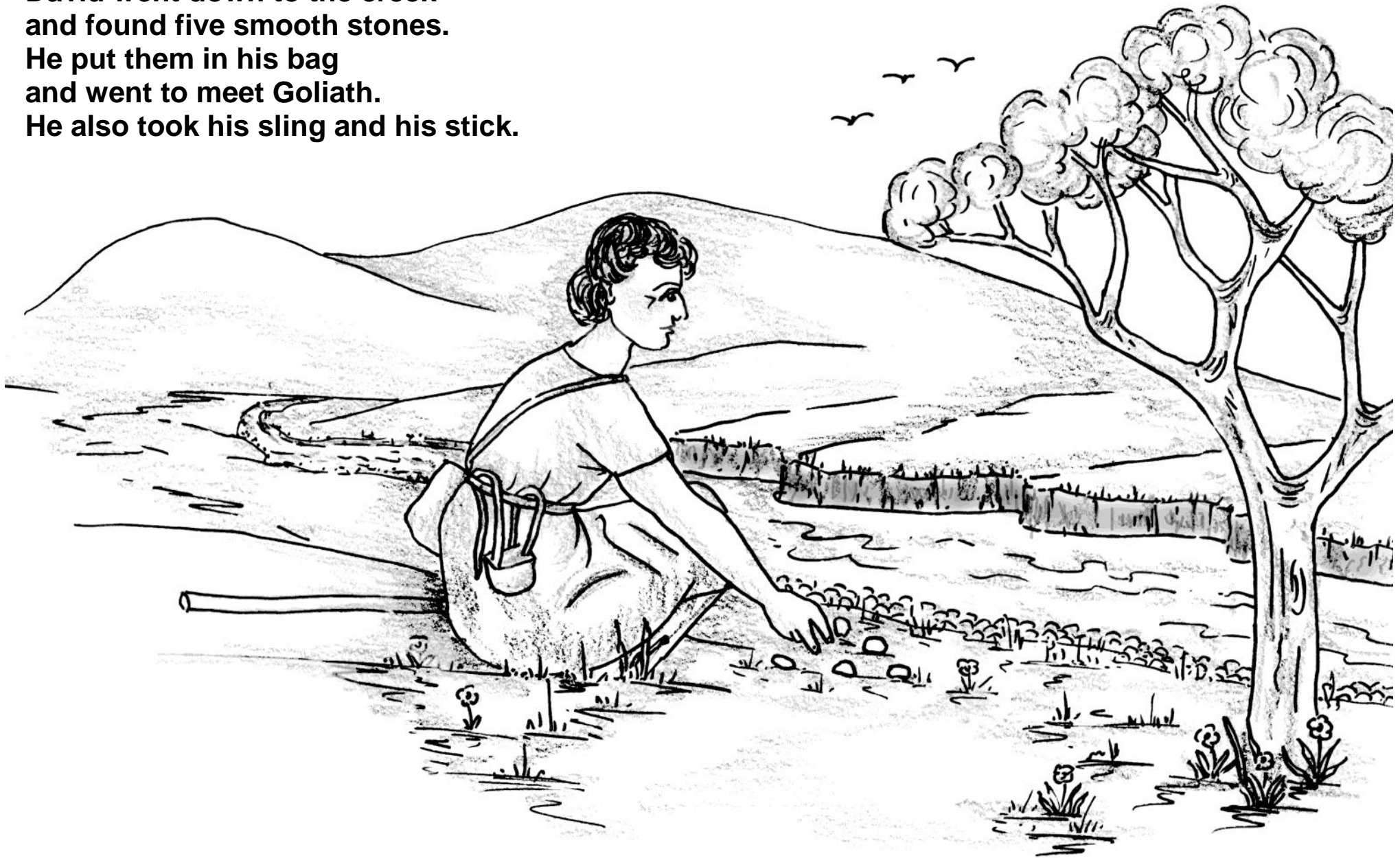


**Saul gave David his armour to wear,  
but it was too big and heavy.**



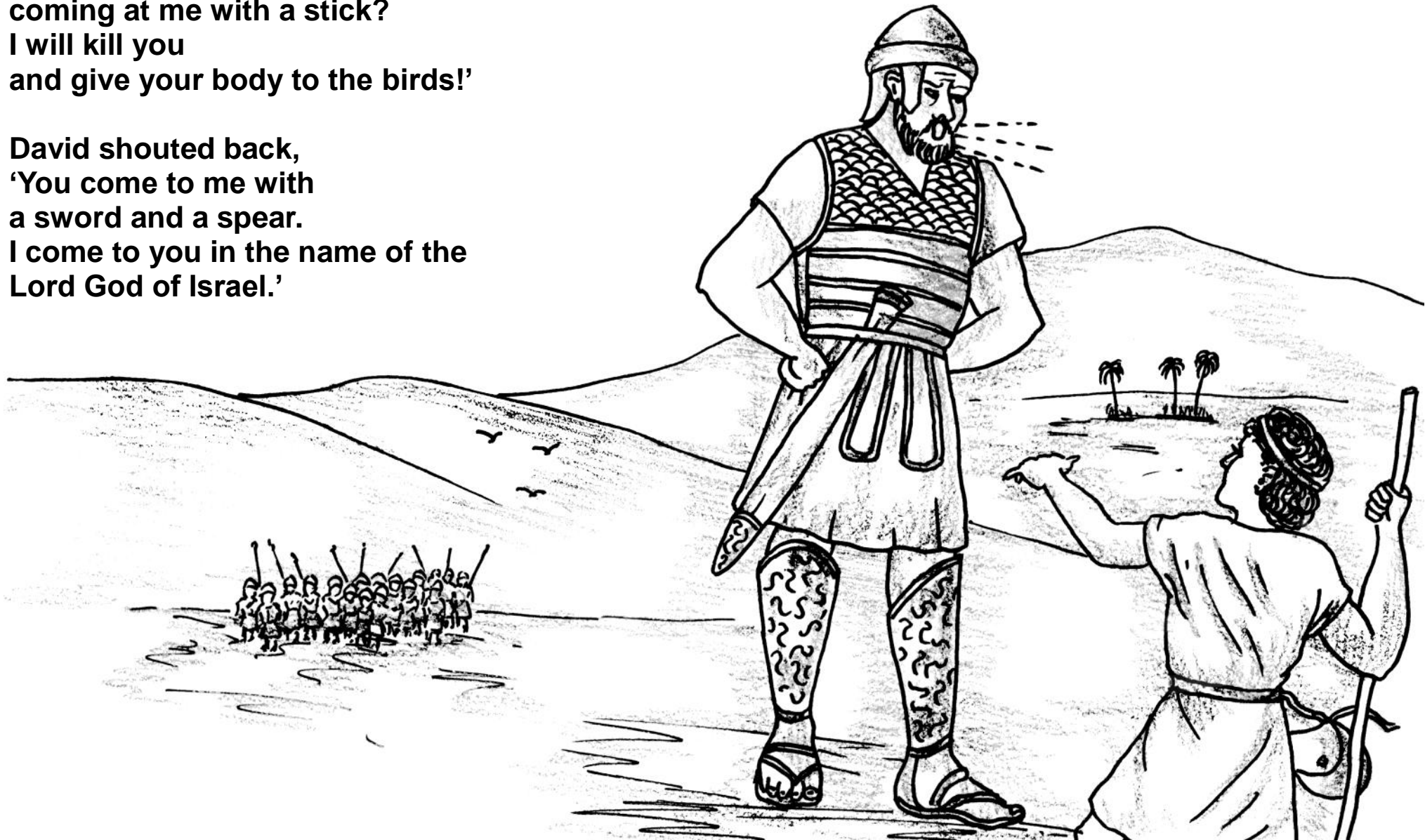


**David went down to the creek

Lord God of Israel.'**

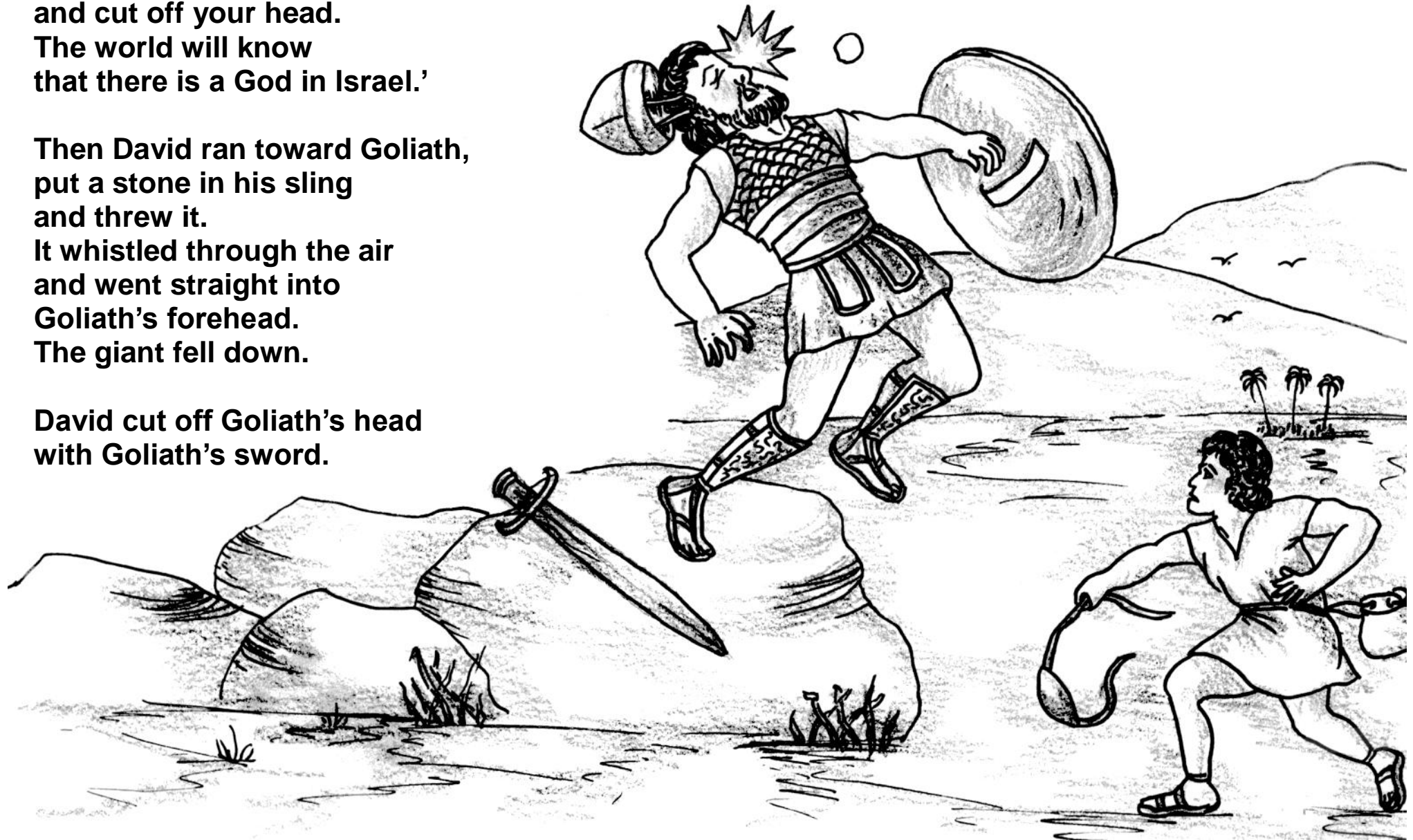




**'You have spoken against God.
